The Bath Jewish Burial Ground is one of many religious sites which developed in the Georgian era as visitors to Bath, and the local community which served them, increased in number. This cemetery was established in 1812, outside the City in the suburb village of Combe Down. We are developing site wide interpretation including a small exhibition in the caretakers cottage.
