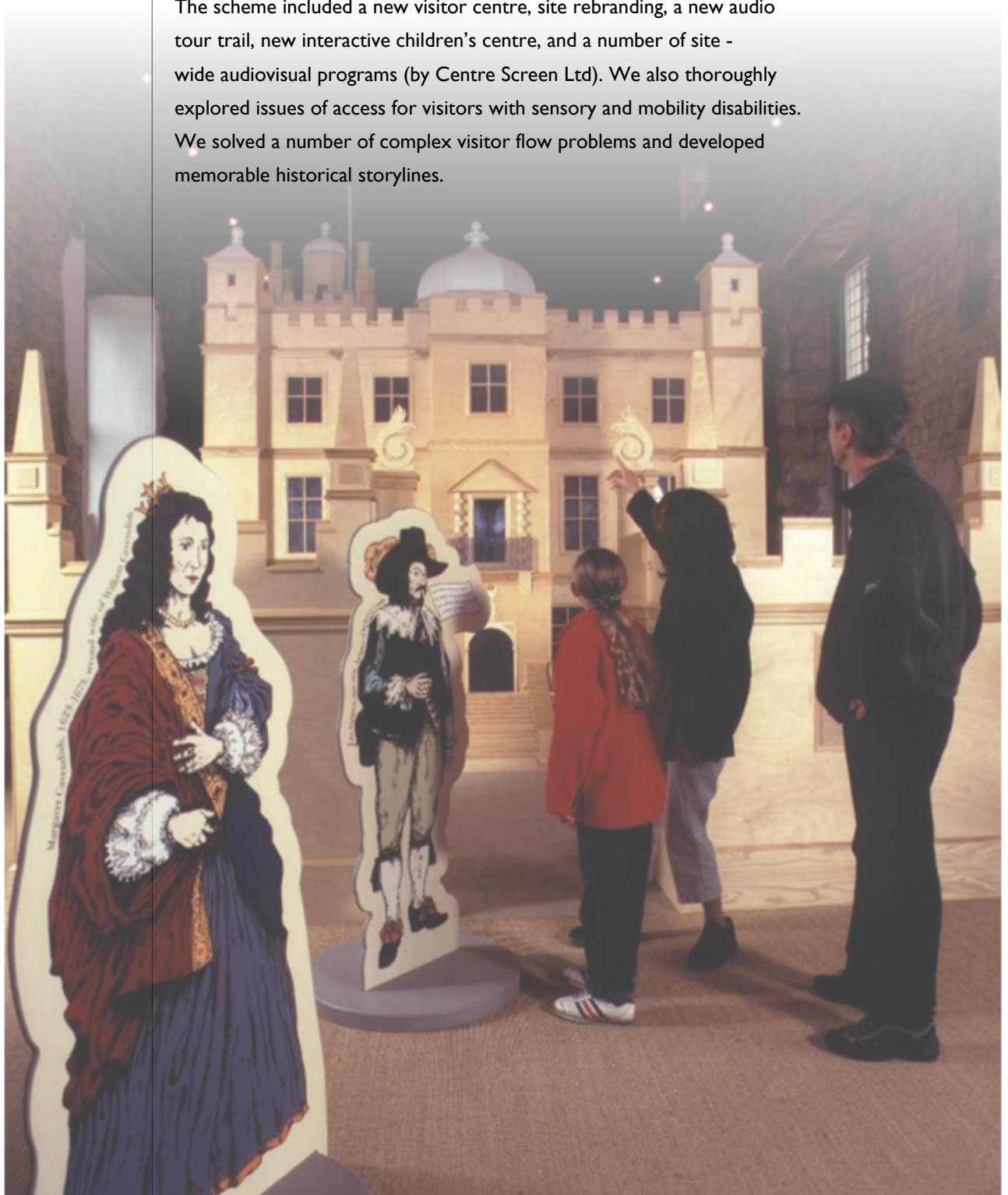

Working for our long term client, English Heritage, we developed a number of new visitor experiences within a scheduled ancient monument. The scheme included a new visitor centre, site rebranding, a new audio tour trail, new interactive children's centre, and a number of site-wide audiovisual programs (by Centre Screen Ltd). We also thoroughly explored issues of access for visitors with sensory and mobility disabilities. We solved a number of complex visitor flow problems and developed memorable historical storylines.
