It was 75 years since King Edward's School left the Sir Charles Barry Building (Barry was the architect of the Houses of Parliament) on New Street, Birmingham.

To celebrate the occasion, the school hosted an exhibition of archive material related to the building. The exhibition was held in the school's chapel, which was originally the upper corridor of the Barry Building, before being moved to its present location.

We discovered in the archive a set of unique 3D glass slides of the long lost building which were converted to an in gallery film. The displays charted the history of the building and displayed pieces of furniture designed by Augustus Pugin, the interior and furniture designer.
